

Within the framework of the **annual congress** of the Swiss [Society of Psychiatry and Psychotherapy](#) (SSPP) **from 12 & 13 September 2024 in Bern**, the "SO-PSY Luc Ciompi Prize" will be awarded for valuable research work that follows the humanistic and scientific vision of the founder.

The prize-winning themes concern the role of the interaction between emotions and cognition on the understanding and treatment of psychoses, as well as psychosocial approaches that promote social inclusion and the achievement of a fulfilled life. Particular attention will be paid to research involving expert patients in all stages from conception to publication.

After four editions of the "Luc Ciompi Award", the Swiss Society for Social Psychiatry (SO-PSY) will ensure the continuation of the award under the name "SO-PSY Luc Ciompi Award" from 2023 onwards. Relevant work can be submitted electronically to the SO-PSY secretariat (contact@so-psy.ch) **before December 31, 2023**.

In addition to a brief CV of the main author, they should contain a description of maximum half a page on the importance of the submitted work for the mentioned problem. The rules of the prize and more detailed information are available on psychiatrie.ch, ciompi.com and so-psy.ch.
